COLUMBIA HOSPITAL HONORED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF HAITI

On a recent trip to the United States, several Haitian government officials made a special trip to Columbia Hospital to thank the hospital, Dr. Albert LaTorra, and Dr. Wilhelm Larsen for their



support of the people in Haiti. Over the past several years Dr. LaTorra and Dr. Larsen have raised funds and collected used equipment, furniture, and medical supplies from the hospital to refurbish a medical clinic in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. Close to \$4 million worth of donated items have been shipped to Haiti to enable hundreds of Haitians to receive much needed medical attention.
